In 2008 Zak Designs received a number of inquiries regarding whether or not the Zak Designs licensed children's mealtime products contain bisphenol-A (BPA). We would like to take this opportunity to reiterate to our retailers and consumers, and all concerned parents, that **ALL ZAK DESIGNS LICENSED CHILDREN'S MEALTIME PRODUCTS ARE BPA FREE.**

Although we will continue to welcome retailer and consumer inquiries about specific Zak products, we want to assure you that any children's product featuring artwork of today's most popular children's characters contains no BPA.

Additionally, several states and the Federal government have enacted legislation limiting the quantity of certain Phthalates in various children's products and child care articles. Zak Designs has monitored these bills and the affect that they would have on Zak products. Again, we are proud to report that all Zak Designs children's products meet these regulations.

As an international company with an unwavering commitment to safety and quality, Zak Designs has always, and will always, manufacture products that meet or exceed the federal regulations of every country where our products are sold to consumers. We continually test our products for safety and quality in an effort to consistently bring our customers and their consumers safe, high-quality mealtime products that fit with their lifestyles.
